### TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT CORRAL HOLLOW AND VALPICO ROAD SCHEDULED FOR ACTIVATION TOMORROW

*Motorists should anticipate potential delays between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. while the signal is being activated.*

**Tracy, Calif.** – The City of Tracy is excited to announce that construction to install the temporary traffic signal at North Corral Hollow and West Valpico Road is now complete. In an effort to minimize traffic impacts, the signal will be activated between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. tomorrow, November 10, 2022. This intersection is currently a four-way stop, so motorists should plan for potential delays as crews work to safely facilitate the flow of traffic through the intersection while activating the signal tomorrow morning.

The temporary traffic signal consists of wooden poles, heads, controllers, emergency vehicle pre-emption, and will have video vehicle detection technology installed next month. The signal will be powered by generator until overhead PG&E power is established and will remain in place while permanent traffic signals and a full widening of the intersection are designed.

*“We are excited about the successful completion of this project,”* said Associate Civil Engineer Leisser Mazariegos. *“This improvement will bring some much-needed relief to one of our most congested intersections,”* said Leisser Mazariegos, Associate Civil Engineer.

Please use alternate routes tomorrow morning to avoid delays in the area and remember to “slow for the cone zone,” as traffic fines are doubled in construction zones.

Installation of this temporary traffic signal is the first of a seven-phase, long-term Corral Hollow Corridor program designed to improve safety and capacity, alleviate congestion, increase lanes/shoulder width, and improve connectivity for those traveling through our community for generations to come. A new Corral Hollow Corridor website, [www.CHcorridor.com](http://www.CHcorridor.com), has been launched, highlighting the seven construction and improvement phases along Corral Hollow Road. The new site features an interactive map that highlights current and future construction locations, provides updates on active road work, progress photos, anticipated timelines, and a resource section with [frequently asked questions](#).
